- Shows the unique identification number of your processor - Pressing the button, the ID is shown in the form of letters and/or digits. - The number can be copied to the clipboard by pressing the Enter key. @Wiktor Stribizew, a "0" is not even a letter of English alphabet; it's the numerical zero of all numbers that are represented by a letter and a digit, e.g. "ABCD-0". In order to avoid confusion with such numeric representation of letters, in some English speaking countries "0" is not even a letter. That's why the original name of the above tool should probably be "ID of CPU". ID of CPU is a free application written in the C++ language with the help of the MinGW toolchain. It works on Windows XP and later. WARNING: The "C:\Program Files\ID of CPU\ID of CPU.exe" file is encrypted by C++. This is NOT a virus! When a user register, I want to have this kind of query: INSERT INTO users (user_id, name) VALUES (DEFAULT, user.name) How can I set the user_id and name with a default value like DEFAULT? Thanks. A: Laravel has a really convenient feature for that: default values: \$user = User::create(['user_id' => DEFAULT, 'name' => DEFAULT]); Docs on this can be found here. A: That's a job for a Laravel event subscriber. When the user is created (saved), you fire the event and your event subscriber will set the default value. The event code is in the User model: use Illuminate\Database\Events\CreatesUser; public function fire(CreatesUser \$event) { \$event->user_id = DEFAULT; \$event->name = DEFAULT; } Then, in the subscriber (subscriber.php in /app/Listeners), you just need
